

## *Creative Stacked Stitches with Penny Mace*

In this one-day class, students will learn how to make base stitches and stack others on them to create interesting designs for use on Crazy Quilts or to enhance items such as clothing, purses, pillows, etc. Students will be using silk and cotton threads along with beads and buttons. In addition, students will learn the proper way of sewing on beads, how to make beads stand up, how to couch cords and weave fibers through their embroidery.

Each student will receive detailed instruction sheets on each stitch taught and others they may not have time to complete. If there are stitches that students have previously found challenging, the instructor will help them be successful.

Students will need to bring the following: a prepared foundation or other fabrics to practice on; favorite sewing / embroidery needles such as chenille, beading, and embroidery needles; silk ribbon, embroidery floss, other fiber choices, beads and any other do-dads they want to learn to effectively apply to their fabric foundation. In addition, students will find thread scissors, a task light and a pillow for the chair to be useful.



The instructor, Penny Mace will contact each student before the class to see if they have specific questions or need help finding any of the supplies.
