

Intro to Basket Weaving with Mary Sudduth

If creating your own handwoven basket is something you have always wanted to try, then **Intro to Basket Weaving** is the class for you! In this class, you will weave a market basket which incorporates simple beauty with functionality. The market basket is a standard among basket makers and is a great beginners project. Using natural colored reed, students will learn the following skills: creating a woven base, traditional start-stop weaving technique, weaving around a handle, basket shaping, upsetting spokes, lashing and finishing a basket.



Amish blue or Driftwood accent colors will be available or your basket can be all natural in color. Your finished basket will measure approximately 12" long by 6" wide with a 10" handle. This class will be limited to just 6 students so you will get the individual attention you need to be successful.
